Behavior Policy:

We only have 3 rules for Oakdale's Children's Ministries Program:

1. When it is time to have fun, have fun.

This includes participating in group activities and projects. This is a time for you to grow together with your peers and learn about Christ in a fun and productive manor.

2. When it is time to listen, listen.

Please listen anytime a peer, helper, small group leader, or large group leader is speaking to you. Show that you are listening by being quiet when they are speaking, and keeping your eyes on the speaker.

3. Respect your teachers and peers.

Please respect all personal boundaries and church property, as well as be respectful in all verbal and physical actions.

If a Rule is Broken:

The 1st Time: The student will be given a warning.

If a student does break a rule, they will be reminded of that rule accordingly.

The 2nd Time: The student will be put in cool down.

According to the individual leader's preference, the student will be separated from the group or put in the hallway for a short length of time to allow that student to refocus, and have a chance to cool down before rejoining the group.

The 3rd Time: The student will be removed from the group activities and a consequence will follow.

The consequence will most likely be that they will have to shadow an adult assigned to behavioral management for the remainder of the evening. This consequence will include a debriefing or processing period where the student will be asked to think about their behavior and how and why the rule was broken. The student will not be allowed to return to their program until the following week. The parent/guardian will also be notified in this situation.

Please Note: Oakdale Park Church has a zero tolerance policy for any and all violent behavior and/or weapons on the premises. If a student is fighting (verbal or physical) or is suspected of having a weapon, they will be sent home from that evening's programming. It is the parents' or guardians' responsibility to ensure that Oakdale staff can contact him or her if an incident were to occur and the student needed to be picked up. Please help Oakdale keep up-to-date on your contact information. This is to ensure the safety of all participants at Oakdale.
