Rain Gardens: This is the last year for Plaster Creek Stewards rain garden grant money. They can do 10 more curb cut rain gardens (between curb and sidewalk) in the Oakdale neighborhood. Rain gardens capture polluted storm water from the street (contaminants and too warm) and redirect it into a garden with native plants that filter and degrade pollutants naturally. Currently the storm water goes down storm drains and into Silver Creek which is now in an underground pipeline to Plaster Creek.
