Oakdale Announcements

In this Influenza season, please be reminded of our nursery policy regarding sick children. It is extremely important to help reduce the spread of influenza by being vigilant about keeping children out of nursery when they are sick. Please be aware of the symptoms of influenza and consider keeping your child at home if they experience these symptoms. Influenza illness is suspected in individuals showing any two (2) of the following symptoms:

- Fever of 100 °F (37.8 °C) or greater
- Cough
- Runny Nose (not explained by allergies)
- Sore throat

Children should be kept away from the nursery until they are fever-free for 24 hours (without fever-reducing medication).
