Our fall season was tinged with grief as a dear friend and colleague in our neighborhood ministry died suddenly at the end of August. We've been walking with his wife and daughters through the loss as we grieve ourselves and determine how to continue his legacy as the neighborhood pastor for the past 25 years.

Our family has been in transition with Jamison moving to study at Calvin University, Tyler establishing himself as a sophomore at Henry Ford Academy Dearborn, Quentin preparing for high school next year, Kristen teaching kindergarten at Charlotte Mason Community School, and hosting a 7 year old foster girl for the last 8 months.

As for our ministry with Hesed Community Church, we are seeing open doors for ministry in all three neighborhoods where we are intentionally serving (Piety Hill, Brightmoor, Morningside). Our major prayer for this year is the development of a consistent gathering of a worshipping faith community that would encompass the discipleship and Christian community development efforts we have made through the past four years. We have also collaborated with Resonate Global Mission and Ann Arbor CRC to begin Cohort Detroit: a one-year equipping program in neighborhood ministry for young adults both from within and outside of Detroit.
