"We are nearing the end of the first phase of the discernment process which has included gathering and evaluating input from the congregation and staff members related to the council mandates. We are creating a report to submit to council by the end of May with insights gathered in these areas: the priorities and strengths of OPC; ministry areas that need attention; recommendations for staff structure to effectively carry out the ministry priorities; job description recommendations; and suggestions on how to enhance being an anti-racist church. The Lord willing, Phase 2 will begin sometime in June which will consist of the search process for the next pastor. We are so grateful for your prayers and support over the past several months.
